How does a W2W Maxiflow Filter System work?

W2W Maxiflow water filter systems need to be plumbed into your cold water supply under the sink, using the hoses and fittings provided.

Once connected, the high-performance, sub-micron filter media removes unwanted chemicals, dirt, pesticides, parasitic cysts and other contaminants from incoming water.

Clean, freshly filtered drinking water is then available 24/7 via the slimline faucet which you need to fit to your sink top.

The W2W Maxiflow single filter system is perfect where under-sink space is limited.

The sealed filter housing is hygienic, extremely quick to replace and eliminates the need to handle contaminated cartridges.

The W2W Maxiflow with a Scale Reduction filter is a great choice for hospitality and food preparation businesses to keep boiling water taps and coffee machine water clean and free from scale build-up.
