How does a W2W Twin Filter System work?

Once fitted, water is filtered through the sediment and carbon filters collecting unwanted chemicals (including PFAS), dirt, pesticides and other contaminants.

Clean, fresh healthy drinking water is then available 24/7 via the slimline faucet fitted to the sink.

Much of Australia's water has a high mineral, metal and calcium content and a mains-fed water filtration system is a cost-effective way to provide safe drinking water for you and your family.

In areas with poor-quality source water, we recommend pairing a twin filter system with a reverse osmosis filter to reduce excess salts, metals, chemicals, bacteria, and viruses for ultimate water purification.
